Please note that while all previous and spent convictions must be disclosed including formal cautions, only offences or cautions which may specifically have a bearing on a person's suitability for working in close proximity to groups of children will be dealt with further.

In cases where there is an ambiguity as to the applicant's suitability, the Northants Basketball Club reserves the right to make further enquiries with the appropriate agencies. However in cases where these enquiries are required the applicant should feel assured that the rights of the individual in terms of confidentiality will be respected at all times.

Once approved, the applicant will be responsible for ensuring that they operate in accordance with the club's guideline and various Codes of conduct.
